### • STEM

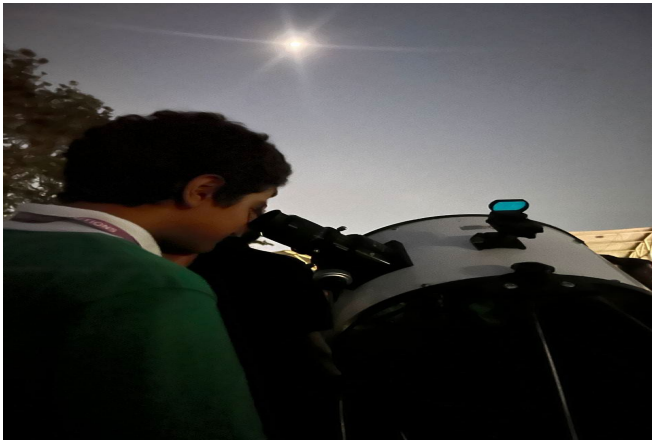
